IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED CONCESSION FORM

Please be advised that the **Concession Form (CL01-Customs)** has been amended to read **Exemption/Concession Form for Import/Export** as per attached. The form now makes provision for importing and exporting particulars.

The revised form, must be used in place of the old concession form, for goods entered under an Exemption or Concession, **<u>import part only</u>**. The form must also be used for goods exported under transshipment or re-exportation regime, <u>the export part only</u> from areas under Customs control, for example a private warehouse.

The amendments made to the form are as follows:

- There is a provision for goods import or exported
- A new line has been added stating "I further declare that the items stated are imported by/or on behalf of ______ for use by ______ ". This is to be used by persons, if goods are being imported on behalf of someone other than the consignee.
- Two (2) new columns have been added to the table for inserting the Customs Procedure Codes, namely the **Extended** and **Additional Code**.
- Two new lines have been added below the table as follows;
 - The <u>Line Item # boxes</u> must be used to show the line items # on the entry, of the item declared for exemption or concession.
 - The **<u>Quantity # boxes</u>** must reflect the actual quantity in number for the line item # above.
- The "<u>CERTIFYING AUTHORITY</u>" box must be completed by the relevant certifying Authority where applicable for example if another Agency/Ministry is the Certifying Authority other than the Comptroller of Customs.
- Under the export section, the "<u>Notice of exportation Under Bond</u>" must be completed for goods exported under bond.
- The "<u>Certificate of Shipment</u>" section must be completed by the officer who witnesses and verifies the shipment of the goods and the master or captain or representative must sign as receiving goods on board vessel or aircraft.
