In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Customs and Excise Department of St. Vincent and the Grenadines takes this opportunity to highlight the guidelines and procedures that Returning Nationals need to adhere to as it relates to both interviews and the processing of paperwork for their goods.

Guidelines for returning	Nationals are as follows:		
1. Application forms	Application forms must be completed in full, m signed and dated, and emailed with all ot supporting documents. (Please download a copy the Duty Free Concessions for Returning Nation Form here)		
2. Supporting Documents/proof of citizenship	A scanned copy of the following documents and a other supporting documents must be attached as uploaded to our website, customs@vincysurf.com Documents include but are not limited to: Copy of passport bio-page as well as the page of the passport where the immigration has stamped reflecting your date of arrival into St. Vincent and the Grenadines. Copy of birth certificate Copy of your deed Copy of retirement letter Copy of pension approval Copy of citizenship approval Copy of employment record		
3. Interviews	Customs will contact clients to schedule interview which will be held via telephone, WhatsApp video Skype where possible. (Please be sure to enter yo contact information in the space provided on the application form.)		
4. Processing of paperwork	All declarations will be processed online. (Plea speak to your broker to relay necessary information for online declaration.)		
5. Payments	Customers are asked to set up Deposit accounts order to facilitate making payments without havi to visit the customs office. (Speak to your broker help with the process of setting up the account.)
